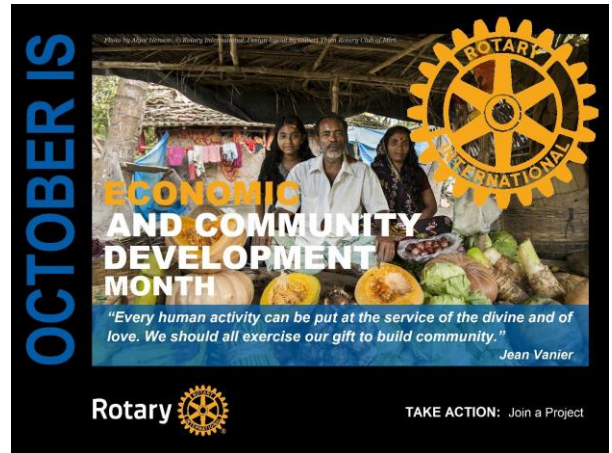

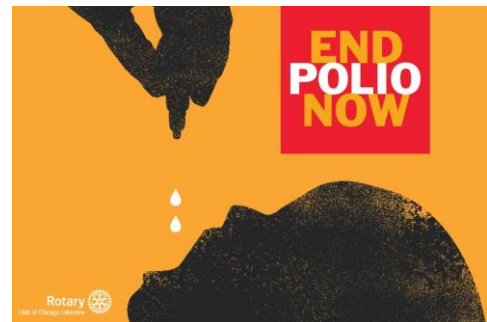
### Our Impact on Local Economies
