Our Annual Goal to The Rotary Foundation

Each year, Rotary Club Presidents set their goals for membership, service, The Rotary Foundation (TRF) and more and inform the District of those goals. Our goal to the Annual Fund of The Rotary Foundation this year is \$6,000. These funds come from our Happy Dollars, Foundation Gifts aka Door Prizes, and personal gifts from members. The majority of our members are Paul Harris Sustaining Members, which means they donate at least \$100 annually to TRF, usually adding just \$25 to their quarterly dues/meals invoices. As of December 31, 2018, we have sent \$2,282.89 to TRF for Sustaining Members. The collected funds from our meetings will be sent at the end of the Rotary year and we will award Paul Harris Fellowships with this money. We need your support of The Rotary Foundation.
