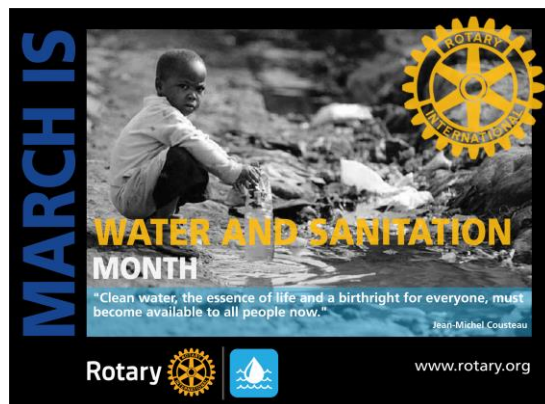

Register Now for Rotary Leadership Institute (RLI)

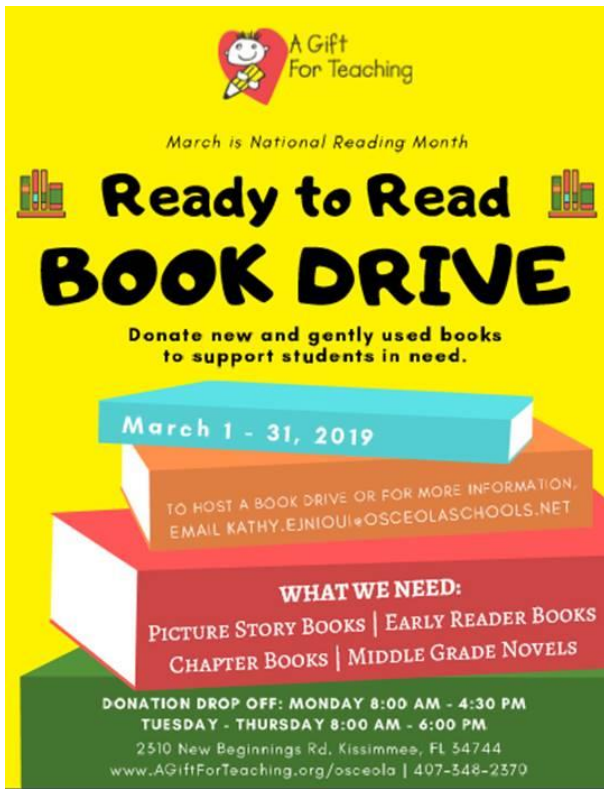
March 23, 2019 Rosen College of Hospitality in Orlando
