Paperwork for sponsorships and auction item requests are available at the club meeting and were sent to you by email.

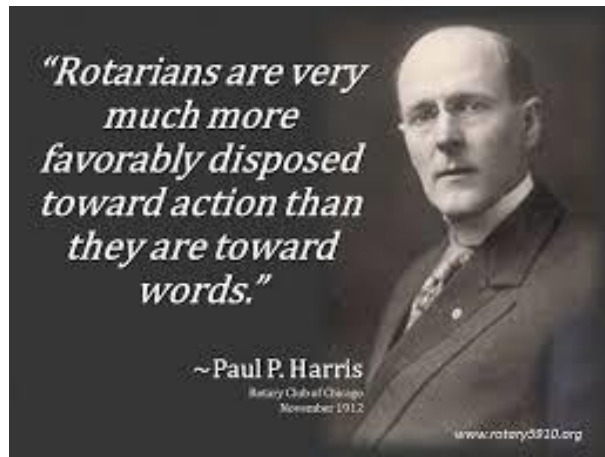
